

WHAT IS AN EFP?

The Alberta Environmental Farm Plan (EFP) is a whole **farm environmental risk assessment** tool.



Voluntary and free!



Complete your EFP with the help of a trained EFP technician.



Complete your workbook online at www.albertaeFP.com.



All of your information is kept confidential.



Depending on your farm, your EFP can be completed in approximately 4-8 hours.

REASONS TO COMPLETE AN EFP:

- ✓ Create awareness and assess environmental risks in your operation.
- ✓ Highlight where your farm could improve resiliency.
- ✓ Essential to the sustainable production of crops and livestock.
- ✓ Increase efficiencies and reduce production costs.
- ✓ Key for marketing and sustainable sourcing requirements and programs.
- ✓ Use as a future planning tool.
- ✓ Can be a requirement for some government funding programs.

DO EFP EXPIRE?

Yes. EFP certificates need to be dated within the last 10 years to be considered current. You can renew your workbook online. We encourage you to update your EFP regularly.

Completing an EFP online makes future renewals simpler and easier.

Data entered into your account will be saved, and will not have to be re-entered for the next renewal.

If you previously completed a paper workbook, use it as a reference when you use the online tool.
